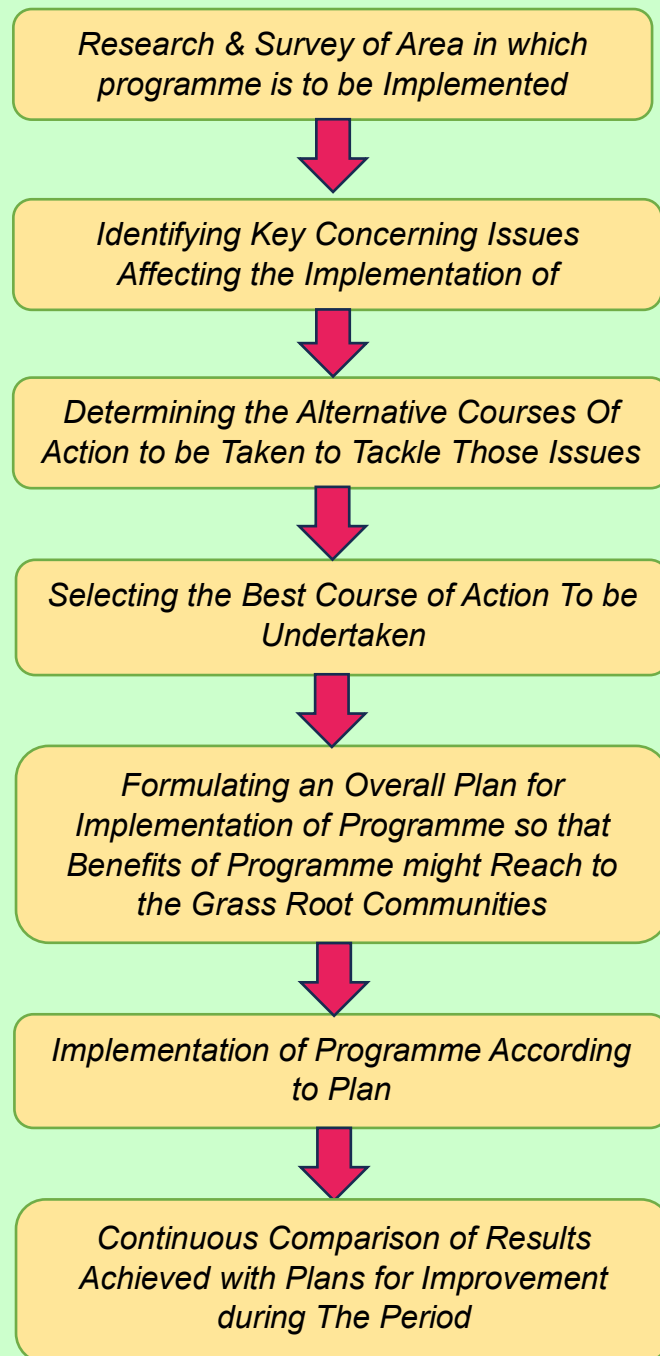

➤ Distribute Ration Kits

The organization with the combination of Koderma Block. Ration kits was distributed among the poor and helpless peoples. This program was done in many villages of Koderma block. distributed among about 900-1000 peoples. This programme was organized by president, secretary and other staffs of the organization.

➤ Distribute Mask and Sanitizer

The organization with the combination of Koderma Block. distributed Masks, sanitizers and soaps. This program was done in many villages of Koderma block. distributed among about 900-1000 peoples. This programme was organized by president, secretary and other staffs of the organization.



➤ Distribute Onion, potato and mustard oil

The organization with the combination of Koderma Block. Onion, potato and mustard oil were supplied to many villages of Koderma block. Distributed among the poor and helpless peoples. This programme was organized by president, secretary and other staffs of the organization.

➤ Training of Menstrual Hygiene

The Organization in association with Arohan Financial Services Limited Kolkata, West Bengal. Four-day training was given to 600 students at Kasturba Gandhi Vidyalaya Markachho and Jaynagar in Koderma district. Menstrual hygiene training was imparted and sanitary napkin vending machines and disposal machines were installed. And the parents of all the students were called and trained on sanitary napkins and sanitary machines.



➤ Ration Kits Distribution

The Organization in association with Jiv Daya Foundation (JDF). Ration kits were distributed among migrant laborers and helpless people. Ration kits were distributed to 255 peoples. Ration kits were distributed at Lariyadih, Nauwadih, Purnanagar, Saphi and Dhab. These are five villages of Koderma district. We saw that all of them were very happy because they were not able to meet their needs due to the lockdown, at that time our organization had given them ration kits.



➤ International Women's day Celebration

On 08th March 2021 organization celebrated International Women's Day in Birsa Sanskritik Bhawan. In this programme about 50-60 people was involved.
